1. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the church reclaims, you must cancel your declaration. Please notify the Treasurer.
3. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Treasurer or, refer to help sheet IR65 on the [HMRC web site](#).
4. Please notify the Treasurer if you change your name or address.
5. The St Johns Church PCC will claim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008, and 25p of tax for every £1 you give or gave since 6 April 2008.
6. The Government will pay to the Charity an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011, but this transitional relief does not affect your personal tax position.
7. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
